Details about Accommodation:

Details about Conference

Granville is a small town but widely spread and without a big conference center so useful for big events such as our Douzelage GM. It will be held outside Granville in “Le Chateau Bonheur”. We will have to go there by coach. We will have enough room for the general meeting, the Education Meeting and the young meeting.

Non-official delegates:

Non-official delegates are welcome, we hope to find accommodation for all of them. The fee for non-delegates covering accommodation, catering, local transport and programme costs will be **255 €**.

This delegate will be officially mandated by the town to replace the mayor (official document needed) – The town official seal will be needed, please bring it with you.

Concerning the possible financial help. One town has already been interested. The idea is to subscribe to a Comenius project (leader Granville) A maximum of 5 towns can apply. The first visit (preparatory visit) will be in Granville (during the GM) Travelling will be covered by EU funds. You can still apply.
