Education Meeting 2011 in Granville

Theme:

„Reducing **early school leaving**, improving the learning of students with migrant background and promoting **gender equality** and **inclusive approaches** to learning”
“early school leaving”

Early school leaving (ESL) remains a major challenge in the E.U. While many young people with a migrant background are successful students, their average performance is lower compared to their native peers.

“gender equality”

Similarly, differences between male and female students in interest and performance in certain subjects persist.

“inclusive approaches”

Schools, together with other actors, can thus play a crucial role both in tackling early school leaving and improving the learning of students with migrant backgrounds.

Task:

identify and develop both school-wide and student-focused **strategies and methods** that help students at risk of **ESL** to maintain their motivation and complete their studies, and prepare them for further education and training;

identify and develop **ways to support and motivate** students with **migrant backgrounds** to fulfil their education and training;

identify and develop both school-wide and student-focused **strategies** to tackle **gender stereotypes** in teaching, learning and career choice;

In how far do you or your school support the development of inclusive approaches to teaching and learning that cater for the needs of all students, including those from disadvantaged backgrounds?
