3) Approval of the accounts 2005 – 2006

Accounts will have to be checked by the two Honorary Auditors, Bernard Husson from Granville and Chris MacAdie from Sherborne.

Referring to the Meerssen GM [para 4) [a], page 5 of the Minutes] it was agreed on an extension for the approval of the accounts until the Sherborne meeting in autumn 2006. According to this extra extension the accounts presented will cover the period from 01 April 2005 to 30 September 2006 [ANNEX C] (*The annex will follow early October*)

Towns are kindly asked to check their situation concerning the payments of the annual contribution [ANNEX D] and the translation equipment participation [ANNEX E]. Outstanding payments are welcome!

4) Annual Douzelage membership

It is proposed to remain at 300 € for the annual fee according to the decision taken in Sesimbra [Sesimbra, para 2, 15/08/2003]

5) Simultaneous Translation accounts

10) The "Youth in Action" Programme 2007-2013

[a] Documentation

After the very positive symposium in Köszeg on Youth for Europe program, important training kits have been placed at the disposal of all those who are planning or running Youth activities.

The training kits are thematic publications written by experienced youth trainers. They are easy-to-use handbooks for use in training and study sessions. T-Kits are produced in English, French & German and in some other languages too. See <u>www.douzelage.org/youth</u>.

As a good example, it must be underlined that in the "Youth for Europe" programme evaluations at the end of the activity must be made. How to manage Youth projects and all the details needed can be found in the document <u>T-Kit 3 – Project Management</u>. It is important that evaluations include all essential items asked by the EC.

[b] Training courses

It will also be possible to provide non formal education for Youth project leaders in the future. Towns interested in sending youth workers to these seminars should inform the Douzelage Secretary.

[c] Dissemination of information

The Douzelage receives a large number of invitations to youth activities all over Europe. Towns interested in participating to these activities should notify the Douzelage Secretary.

Due to the important discussion points on the New EU-Programs, the Douzelage enlargement and the future steps, detailed verbal reports on the different town activities will possibly be missed out or shortened.

Therefore all towns are kindly requested to send as soon as possible a brief description of their Douzelage activities since the meeting in Meerssen (both internal and external), together with their plans for the future to the Douzelage Secretary, who will summarize them.
